## HUNTING ETIQUETTE

---

The following suggestions will help those not familiar with hunting to better understand the etiquette of the sport.

Upon arrival it is customary to greet the Master and introduce any guest. Male riders when mounted are not required to remove their caps when being addressed by the Master.

Do not impede other riders whilst traversing a jump.

Correct Hunting Attire is:

AS3838 approved black cap, Pink/Black coat with Wattle collar, White breeches, White shirt and stock and Black boots. However a hacking jacket with fawn or white jodhpurs is permissible. Riders are only entitled to wear a "Pink" or Black Jacket at the invitation of the Master and should then do so at all Hunts thereafter (except where otherwise stated).

Junior riders are expected to wear a Hacking Jacket, preferably not a dark colour.

Riders and horses should be turned out as well as possible to compliment the club, its Master and Landowners. If the standard is insufficient the Master may order the person to retire.

Riders must neither mount nor dismount until the Master has done so, except before the Hunt starts.

Always be on time for hunts. If you do arrive late, travel via the roadside until you reach the field, and then request permission from the Master to join the field. Similarly, if you wish to retire from the Hunt, seek permission from the Master or Field Master to do so. Never dismount prior to the Master without seeking the Field Master's permission.

Always stay 20 metres behind the Field Master. Adhere strictly to any instructions that the Master or Field Master may give. Never jump an obstacle that the Master or Field Master has not jumped.

If you are riding a known kicker, avoid people and other riders. Tie a red ribbon on the horse's tail. Keep green horses and kickers to the rear of the field. Your obligation regarding horses that kick does not cease whilst dismounted, during Stirrup Cup and at the conclusion of the hunt.

Do not smoke whilst mounted

Attend to your horse before proceeding to the Stirrup Cup or BBQ. Refreshments will not be served before the Master has opened the bar. Correct Hunting attire should be worn until after the speeches.
